

RECYCLE AT SUPERMARKET

Take back the plastics below to plastic bag collection points at the larger stores of most major supermarkets including Tesco, Asda, Morrisons, Sainsbury's, The Co-op and Waitrose.

For online shopping deliveries, many supermarkets also allow you to hand your unwanted bags back to the driver for recycling.

WHICH TYPES OF PLASTIC FILM CAN BE RECYCLED?

Yes please	No thanks
All plastic bags, except biodegradable or compostable bags	Any non-Polyethylene film (e.g. PP, PVC, others)
Bread bags	Cling film
Breakfast cereal liners	Food and drink pouches
Shrink wrap & ring joiners from multipacks of water, cans etc	Wrappers from bakeries, e.g. bags with lots of small holes in them
Frozen food bags, e.g. bags for frozen vegetables, chips, etc	Film lids from trays and pots, e.g. yoghurt pots
Dry cleaning bags/bags covering new clothing	Any dirty bags or film, for example containing food
Magazine and newspaper wrappers	Crisp packets
Bags for loose fruit and vegetables	Compostable bags
Bubble wrap	Any film claiming to be biodegradable
Low-density polyethylene (LDPE) - resin ID code 4	Pre-prepared salad bags
