Terms & Conditions

Terms and conditions of entry

1. The competition is open to school pupils and uniformed group (scouts, girl guides, army, sea and RAF cadets), children and young people entered by their parents, guardians, uniformed group leader or teacher. They must be resident in Hampshire and Sussex, aged between 5 and 16 on the closing date of the competition – 12 noon on Monday 20th June 2022.
2. Each artist can enter more than one category. Schools and groups can print additional forms as required. Category as indicated on the official entry form.
- 3.. Any contact details supplied will be used solely for administering the competition and will not be published or provided to any third party without the explicit permission of either the Head Teacher of the entering school or the teacher within the school responsible for their participation in the competition.
4. The deadline for receiving entries is 12 noon Monday 20th June 2022 Any entries received after this deadline will not be considered.
6. Only entries that comply with all entry instructions will be accepted.
7. A representative of the entrant’s school, parent or guardian must submit the entry on the pupil’s behalf and by doing so agrees and accepts: a) these terms and conditions; b) that South Downs National Park Trust may publish competition entries both in print and online, including on their websites, social media channels, and for PR purposes; c) that the winning pupil(s) may be invited to participate in publicity arising from this competition.
8. Entries will be accepted on the ‘Art in the Park’ Competition Entry Form, download from [Schools - South Downs \(southdownstrust.org.uk\)](https://southdownstrust.org.uk)
9. If submitting an image including the child artist/artists the school, parent or guardian will be asked to submit a consent form.

This should include completed entry form, photo or scan of the art in JPEG format. Please give the entry form and art a file name including:

Competition category, school, pupils full name and entry for example
‘cat1_Midhurst_JoeSmith_entryform or cat1_Midhurst_JoeSmith_art.jpeg. If a school or group is submitting multiple entries please use We Transfer or Dropbox.

10. Please ensure that the attachments do not exceed 10MB in total. If we need a larger file size of any image(s) or scan(s) we will contact the named person on the entry form.
11. South Downs National Park Trust takes no responsibility for late entries, or entries not successfully uploaded.
12. Entries must be the original work of the entrant(s) and not copied from any other source.
13. The judging panel will select one winning entry and two runners up from each of the competition categories which have been received by the competition deadline, 12 noon Monday 20th June 2022
14. The decision of the judges is final and at the absolute discretion of South Downs National Park Trust's panel. No correspondence will be entered into.
15. The winning art per age category will receive a gift to the value of £75,
16. The winning schools/entries will be contacted by email, telephone or by mail by 8th July. If the winning schools/group/parent/guardian cannot be contacted after reasonable attempts have been made, South Downs National Park Trust reserves the right to offer the prize to another competition entrant.
17. South Downs National Park Trust reserves the right to cancel this competition without notice at any stage if it is deemed necessary at the absolute discretion of SDNPT or where events beyond its control prevent proper administration of the competition.
18. These terms and conditions and any disputes arising out of them shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law.
19. The promoter of this competition is South Downs National Park Trust in partnership with Sussex Green Living. The data controller of this competition is South Downs National Park Trust.
