## Art in the Park Eco Art Competition Entry Form

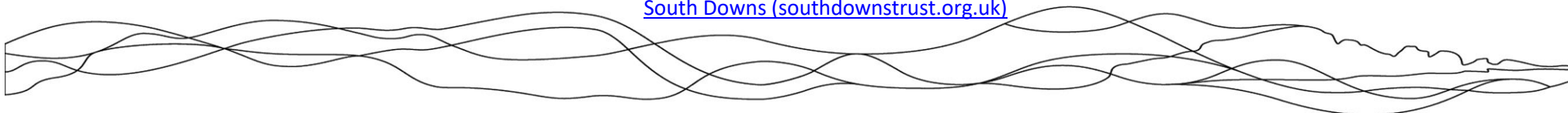
This competition can be entered by schools, uniformed groups or parents. Each artist can enter more than one category.
